Shape: Circle
Color: Red

November

Shape: Star
Color: Brown

Song & Dance: Infants and toddlers love music! Even very young infants respond to music in their own ways. Children will clap, bounce, stomp, jump, and dance to different kinds of music. They will also make their own music by playing simple instruments and with household items.

Fun on the Farm: Life on the farm is filled with adventure! In this theme, children will investigate all aspects of farm life, including animals, barns, harvesting crops, farming jobs, and equipment.

December
