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## Child Progress Report (16–36 months)

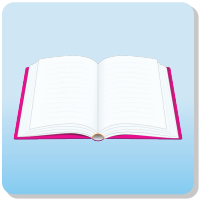
Older toddlers are becoming more independent and are beginning to demonstrate and communicate preferences as a means of control. They enjoy exploring and trying new things by themselves.

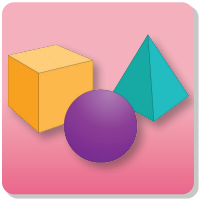

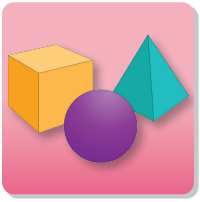
