

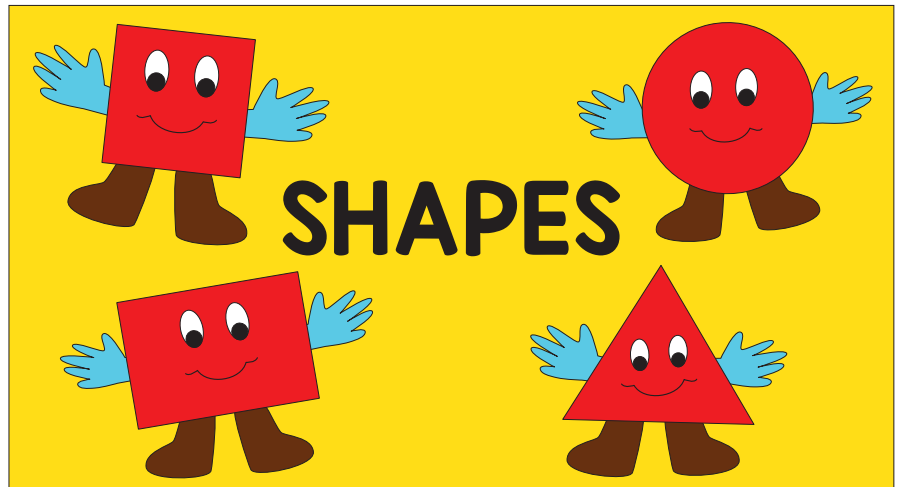
# Build a Print-Rich Environment with Bulletin Boards!

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Ages 0-3

## Shapes

Cover your bulletin board with bright colored paper, and add a decorative border, if desired. Cut large shapes from colored paper, and add eyes and a mouth to each shape to turn them into characters. Choose shapes the children have learned this year. Cut hand and feet shapes to attach to the shape cutouts as well. Attach the shapes to the board, and write the title, "Shapes."

## Fair Fun!

Cover your bulletin board with light-colored paper, and add a colored flag border across the top, if desired. Draw a large Ferris wheel on the board, or cut simple shapes from colored paper to attach to the board as a Ferris wheel. Create enough bucket seats so there is one for each child in your setting. Print close-up photographs of the children, and cut around each child's head. Attach the photos above the buckets, as shown. Add the title "Fair Fun!"

## Chicka Chicka Boom Boom! Look Who's Learning in Our Room!

Cover your bulletin board with paper, and add a decorative border, if desired. Cut a large palm tree from paper, and attach it to one side of the board. Place alphabet letter cutouts on and around the tree. Print photos of the children, and attach them to paper coconuts. Scatter the coconuts around the board. Add the title "Chicka Chicka Boom Boom! Look Who's Learning in Our Room!"
