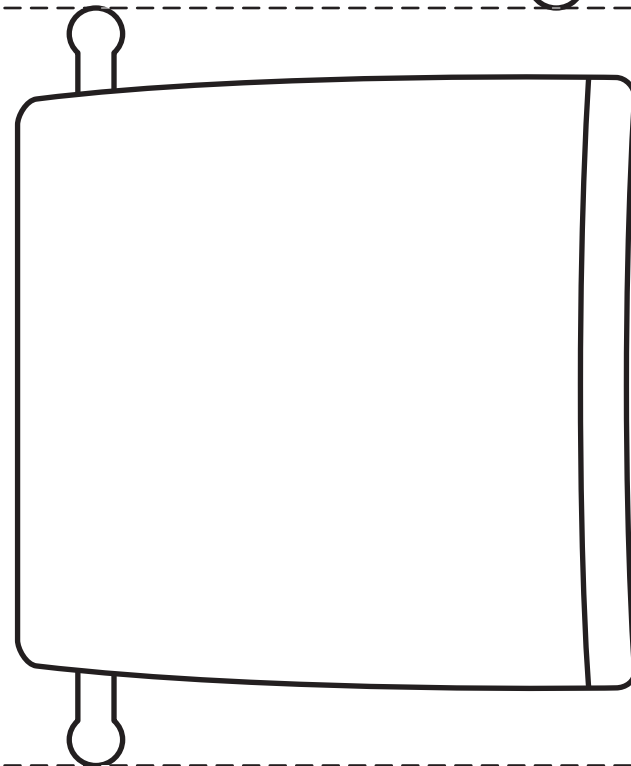
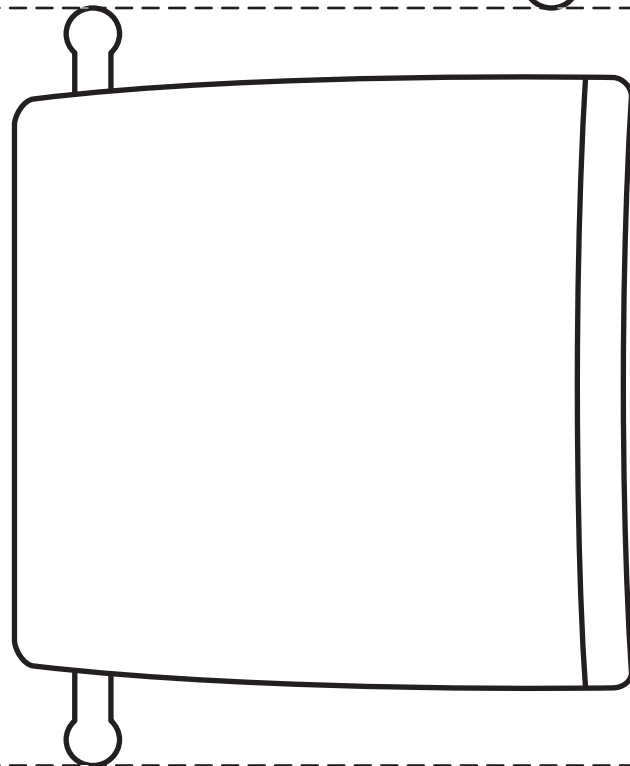
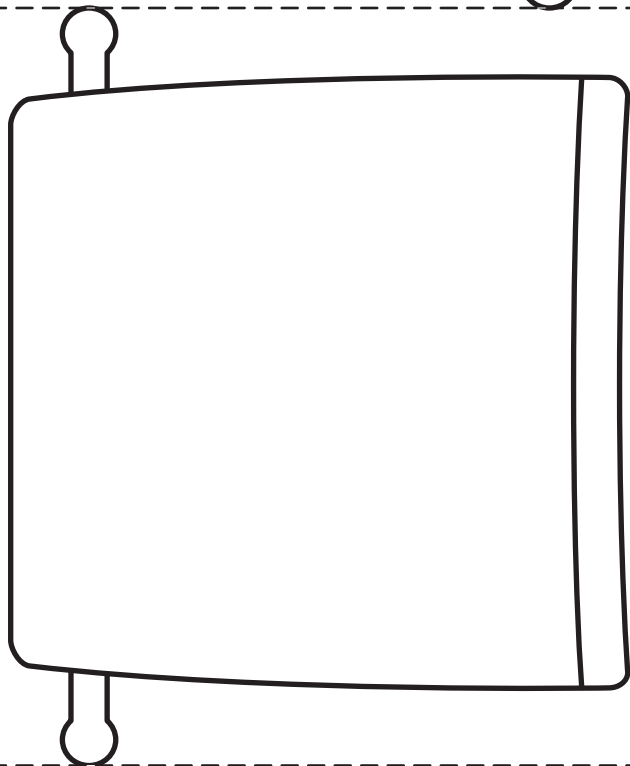
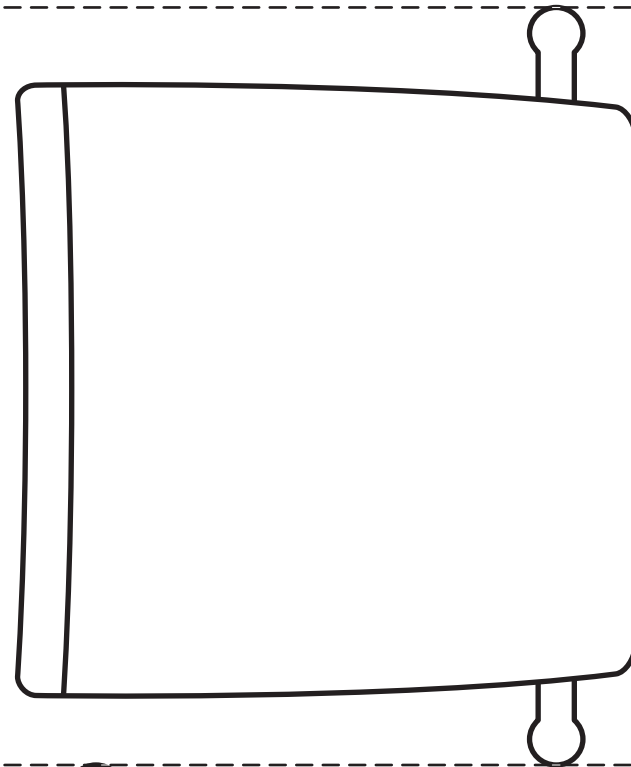
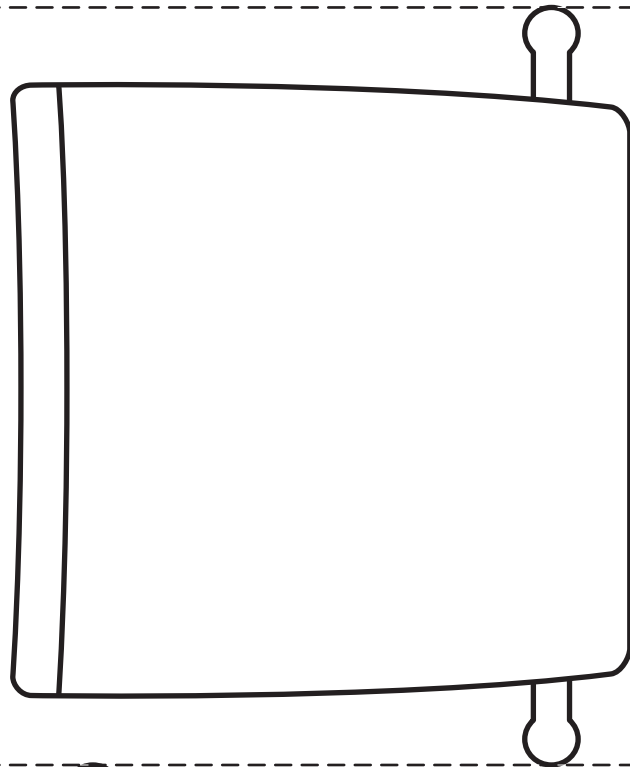
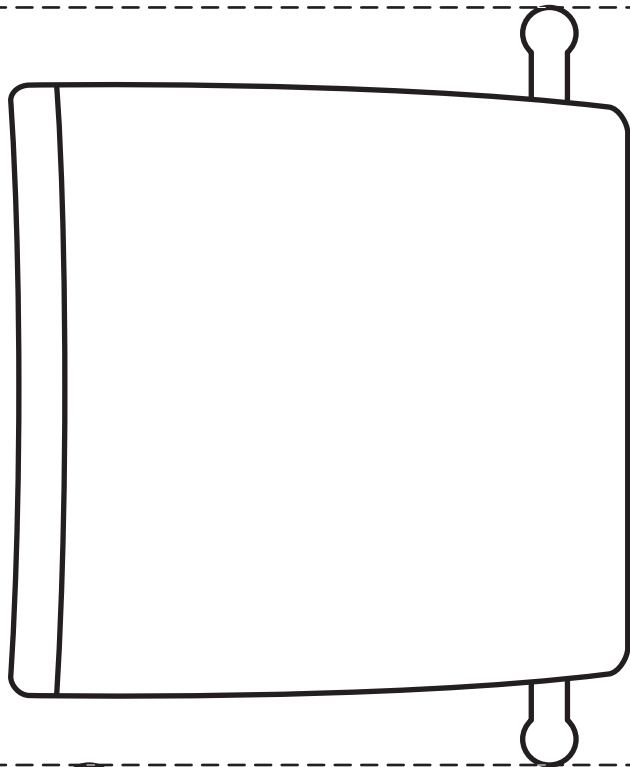
## Questionnaire for Families

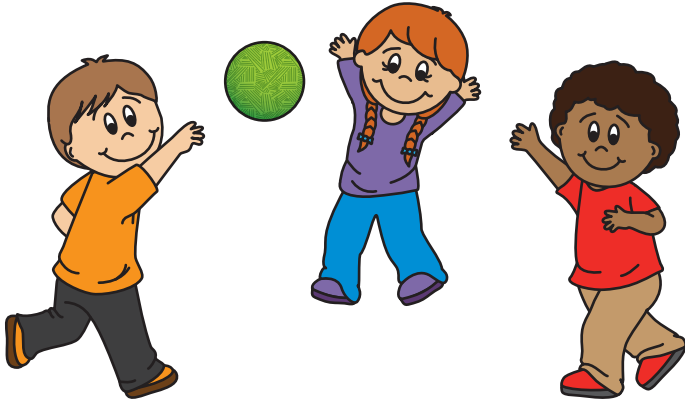
1. Which special occasions and holidays do you celebrate in your family?

8. If your family does not celebrate holidays, what kind of support would you like if/when there are holiday activities?



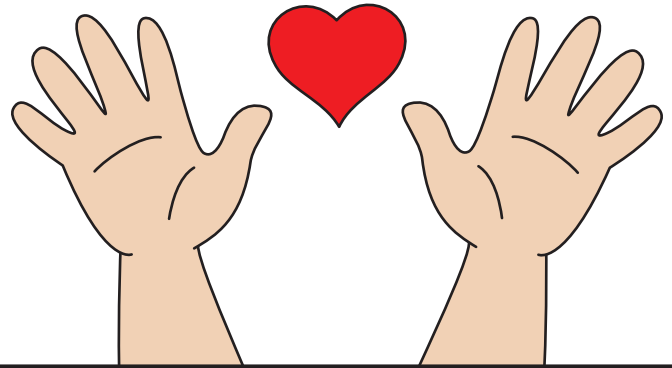
