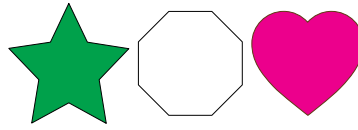
Pond Life

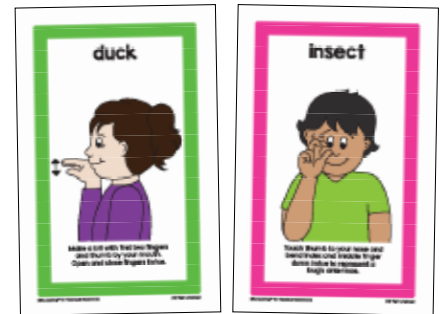

Outside Water Play

Enjoy outdoor water activities together. Visit a local splash pad or swimming pool. Set up a sprinkler in your backyard. Offer your child spray bottles filled with water and invite them to "draw" on pavement with the water.

Bug Hunt

Go on a bug hunt! Search for insects and bugs outdoors with your child. Talk about the different creatures you see. Where do they live? What do they eat? How do they move? Challenge your child to demonstrate how several different types of bugs, such as ladybugs, bees, and ants, move.
