
Build a Print-Rich Environment with Bulletin Boards!

Ages 0-3

Summer Steps

Cut a piece of tan bulletin board paper that is large enough to cover your board. Lay it flat on a patio or another smooth surface. Remove the children's shoes, paint the soles of their feet, and invite them to walk across the paper. Let dry and attach the paper to the board. Add an orange border. Cut large orange letters to form the caption "Summer Steps."





Ages 3-5 **Hello, Summer!**

Cover your bulletin board with blue and green paper to resemble the sky and grass. Add a seasonal border, if desired. Have children help you cut bubble shapes from paper. Attach an empty bubble solution bottle and wand to the board. (You can make a bigger wand out of paper for a large board.) Arrange the bubbles as if they are blowing out of the bubble wand. Attach summer clip art in between the bubbles, and add the title "Hello, Summer!"

Ages 3-5

This Class is Going Places

Cover your bulletin board with white paper and add a red border. Cut triangle shapes from paper to resemble mountains. Cut a length of black paper to resemble a road and add dashed lines using white chalk. Add the pieces to your bulletin board to create an outdoor scene. Print car clip art shapes from the Internet and attach them along the road. Add the caption "This Class Is Going Places" to the board.
