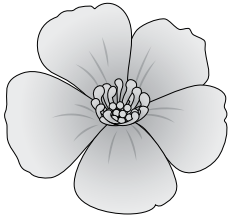


# May Materials List

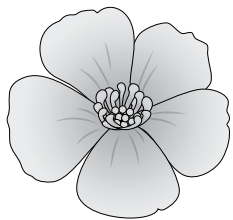
